

Best Practice I- Green, Clean and Eco-friendly Campus

1. Name of the Programme: Plantation of Ornamental Flowers in the college Garden:

Day 1:- The workshop was started by a brief lecture on the importance of Birds in the Eco-System and the role of every individuals in the preservation of birds. "The lecture was delivered by Prasanna Kalita, Resource person of the workshop. A brief introduction was given by dr. Nara Kanta Adhikary, Principal Dakshin Kamrup Girls' College, Mirza.

The workshop was started at 6.00 AM. The resource person informed the technique of birds counting. He informed the participants that how we can count a bird through observation and listing the sound of the bird with the help of binoculars and cameras, birds were observed and captured. The resource person informed the local, common and scientific names of the bird

seen in the campus during survey. The survey was conducted for two hours from 6.00 AM to 8.00 AM.

Day-2:- On Day two the workshop again started at 6.00 AM. The team members of Bonyabondhu lead the group in to Two parts and observed and count the birds seen around the campus. Again the resource person, Mr. Prasanna Kalita took brief introduction session with the participants about the observation. He also report the Importance of bird count system for an educational institution.
