1. Swachh Bharat Summer Internship -100 hours of Swachhta (20-06-2018 to 04-07-2018)

11. Plantation programme (10-08-2019)

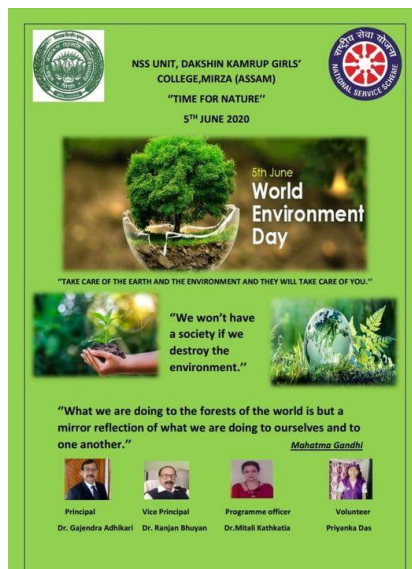

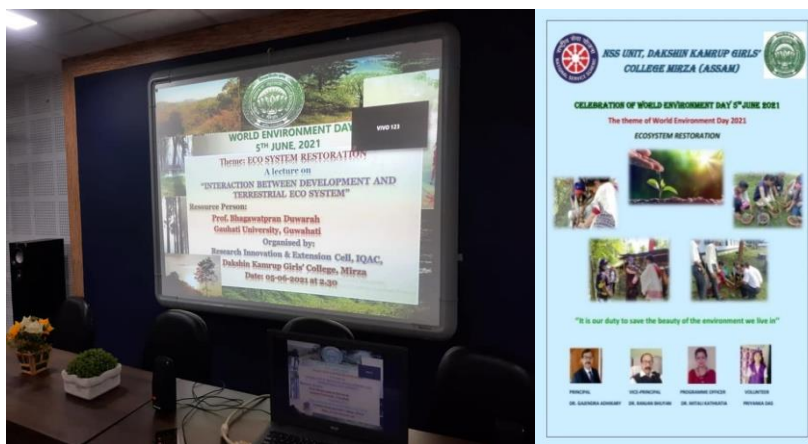

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel who played an important role in uniting India. Known as the 'Iron Man' of India, he was also a founding leader of the Republic of India.

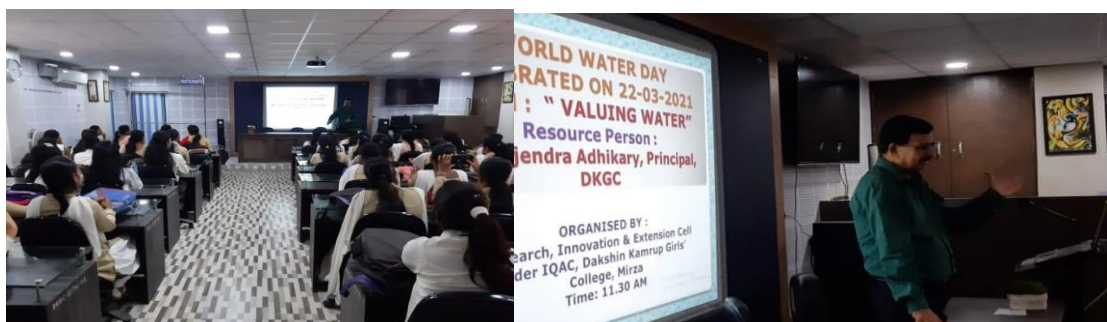

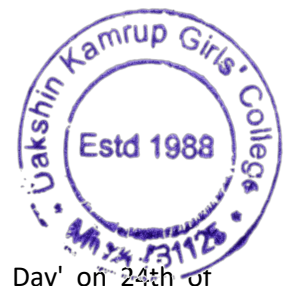

Title of the Practice: Healthy People Healthy Nation Initiative:

Programme undertaken in 2018-2019 Session under these practices

1. As a part of its continuous endeavor to serve the society, the NSS unit of Dakshin Kamrup Girls College, Mirza organised a blood donation camp on 22-09-2018 in association with the GMCH, Guwahati. NSS volunteers, Students Teaching and non-teaching staff of the college came forward for the noble cause with great vivacity. 13. In order to create awareness about Covid 19, a demonstration on the preparation of hand made sanitizer was given by Ms. Richa Kalita, on 20.3.2020.



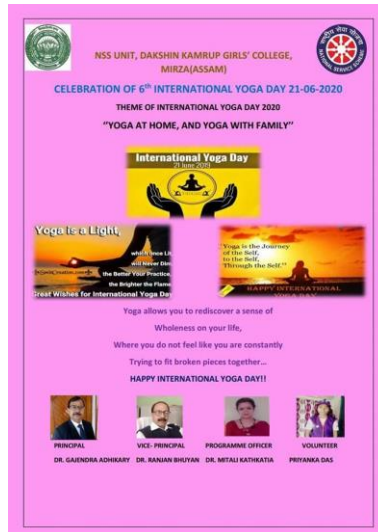
14. Some moments of the Awareness Drive against COVID-19 organised by Dakshin Kamrup Girls College, Mirza on 21st March, 2020.

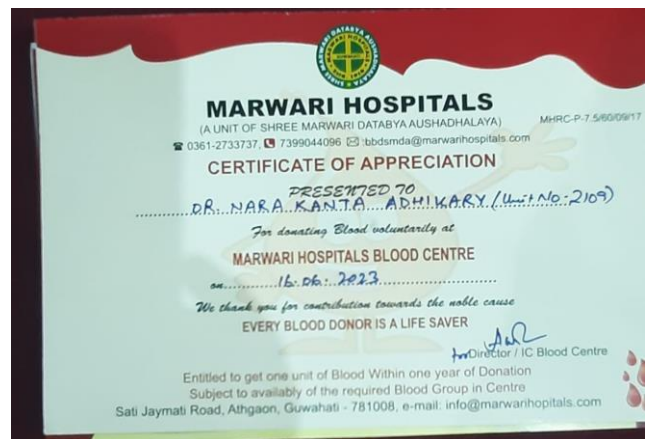


48. **Name of the Programme: Free Health Check-Up on 2/2/2023**
