A guardian meeting was held on 12th August 2022. Various matters were discussed in the meeting.




On 25-07-2022 our Alumni met the Principal of D.K.G. College to discuses the various issues of the college.







On 22.5.2023, The Nehru Yuva Kendra organised a cultural event amongst the students of different schools and college of South Kamrup area, in our institutions.


















NSS / Extension Activities


